Preview Entry forms must be postmarked by May 1st. Late entries must be postmarked between May 2nd and May 15th; late entry cost is \$80 per head.

No Preview entries will be accepted after the postmark date of May 15th.

Please review the guidelines for entering cattle for the show. Animals with pending registrations will NOT be entered until I receive the registration number.
